YOUTH BASKETBALL

The Calais Recreation Department would like to invite all boys & girls in grades K-8 to join our winter basketball programs. We have three separate leagues with boys & girls combined within grades 3/4, 5/6, and 7/8 as well as an introduction to basketball for boys & girls in grades K-2. All three leagues and the introduction to basketball program are taught basketball fundamentals while providing a fun-filled experience.

The programs are open to all Calais residents and those from surrounding communities. All athletes that attend the scheduled team selections listed below are welcome and will be placed upon a team, as well any past players within our programs. Those not attending will be placed upon a waiting list to be placed later, only if there is sufficient space.

All teams play & practice once a week. At this time, Grades 3/4 will play Tu & Th with a weekend practice, and grades 5/6 play M & W with a weekend practice. The grade 7/8 league plays and practices on the weekend (doesn't interfere with the JHS teams). The Intro to Basketball program runs every Saturday morning from 10-11. In December players that are interested in playing within our extensive travel team program will be selected by tryouts from the three different leagues.

All team selections will be held at the Calais Rec. Center from 5:00 to 6:00 on the dates listed below. Parents as well as players should come to fill out the appropriate paperwork and take part in drills to be evaluated on ability. THOSE WISHING TO SIGN UP FOR THE INTRODUCTION TO BASKETBALL PROGRAM ONLY NEED TO FILL OUT THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK. THERE WILL BE NO TRYOUT FOR THIS PROGRAM.

Fee for the 3-8 basketball leagues are \$30 for residents & \$40 for non-residents and should be paid at registration. Fee for the introduction to basketball program will be \$10 for residents & \$20 for non-residents.

YOUTH CHEERING

There will be a mandatory registration for boys and girls in grades K-8 interested in joining the Youth Cheering Program. This year there will be three separate teams for students in grades K-2, 3-5 and 6-8. Participants will learn the basics of cheering and will practice routines to be performed at the two separate competitions. **There will be a mandatory registration at the Calais Rec.
