The Calais School Committee met on Wednesday, November 6, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. as required by City Charter for their organizational meeting. Attending were: Robert Greenlaw, Celia Geel, Joseph Footer, James Macdonald, Thomas Robb and Superintendent of Schools Ronald Jenkins.\

Superintendent Jenkins called the meeting to order and led the board in a Moment of Silence and Pledge of Allegiance.

Superintendent Jenkins called for nominations for Chairman.

Joe Footer nominated Robert Greenlaw.
James Macdonald nominated Thomas Robb.
Celia Geel nomination James Macdonald.

Nominations ceased for Chairman.

Bob Greenlaw received two votes.
Thomas Robb received one vote.
James Macdonald received two votes.

Second round of votes.

Bob Greenlaw received 3 votes.

Bob Greenlaw assume the role of Chairperson and called for nominations for Vice-Chairman.

Joe Footer nominated Celia Geel.

Bob Greenlaw moved to cease nominations.

Unanimous vote to elect Celia Geel as Vice-Chairman.

Motion by James Macdonald, second by Joe Footer unanimous vote to appoint Brian Duffy as the Outdoor Adventure Club advisor and to pay \$200.00 per outing, not to exceed eight trips without board approval.

The board also participated in a conversation regarding hiring an Assistant Principal for the Calais Middle/High School. Superintendent Jenkins was instructed to advertise for a potential position. Motion by James Macdonald, second by Celia Geel, vote of 4 yes, 1 no.

The board also discussed what they would do with the UCC (Congregational Church)
